

Middle School Camp Packing List & Cell Phone Policy

What to Bring:

- Clothes for 3+ Days
- Toiletries, bedding and a pillow – Youthfront provides a mattress only
- Bible (Physical Copy)
- Pen/pencil and a notebook
- Re-Fillable Water Bottle
- Swimming suit & beach towel
- Goggles
- Flip flops/Shoes to get wet
- Sunscreen
- Bug spray
- Hat or visor
- Optional: Sports Equipment (no baseball bats), fishing equipment, card/board games

What NOT to Bring:

- Valuables/money
- iPods, cell phones, or electronics
- 2-piece swimsuits (**) **If camper has a tankini that looks like a 1-piece, that's fine. Otherwise, a t-shirt may need to be worn over it.
- Immodest or over-exposing clothing
- Explicit language or material
- Fireworks
- Weapons of any kind (pocketknives, airsoft guns, slingshots)
- Tobacco, drugs or alcohol

Pro Tips:

- Avoid bringing anything you are worried about losing or breaking!

- Select baggage that accommodates expansion and young packing skills.
- It is helpful to label everything with name to help both campers and volunteers return items to their rightful owners.
- Summer clothes, it will be hot!
- Bring 2 pairs of athletic shoes, and a pair you don't mind getting wet! (flip flops, chacos, crocs, etc.)

Cell Phone Policy

In order to eliminate distraction at camp and limit potential exposure to explicit material, we are having students check in cell phones at registration if you choose to send your student with a phone.

We recommend you leave the phone at home, but if your student brings their phone, we will check them in at registration. Students will be able to check them out for the first 20 minutes of free time on Thursday and Friday for use in the Chapel lobby in order to make a quick call/text home if needed.

Students will not have access to them in the cabins, during session, etc. Cell phone check out will happen at the conclusion of the Saturday Morning session as we are packing and getting ready for parent pick up.

All Legacy staff and adult volunteers will have their phones on them and available at all times, and the camp may be reached at any time via phone in case of emergency.
