GUIDELINES FOR ASSISTANT SPONSORS:

- 1. Students must be high school age.** The only time exceptions will be made is if your parents are attending camp to serve and you need to come with them. Talk with your Elementary Minister if this is the case for your family.
- 2. Students must be a baptized believer and a regular attendee of Legacy.** This week is all about pointing kids to Jesus. We need students who are actively living the Word and who will be a light to the kids at camp. We give priority to students who are currently serving with Legacy Kids Ministry on a regular basis.
- 3. View this week as a privilege.** Being a Sponsor at camp is not a right that you have, but rather a privilege you have been given. As stated above, this is a chance to spiritually invest in the lives of kids, which will have an impact into eternity. Please don't take this lightly!
- 4. Students must demonstrate an "above reproach" attitude, as you are responsible for your actions.** Keep these things in mind. Have another sponsor with you any time you are with a camper. Never be alone with another sponsor of the opposite sex. Camp rules apply to all of us – not just the kids. Camp is not a place to date, nap, play around, etc. You are here to serve Jesus! Remember, you are not in charge, but you might be some day; pay attention and help us make camp great. We are looking for students who are living a Christian lifestyle that is counter-cultural. If you struggle with using bad language, drinking alcohol, using drugs or with even a hint of sexual immorality (Ephesians 5:3), camp is not the place for you. We need adults and students to model Christ to the Legacy Kids.
- 5. Follow the schedule.** As a Sponsor, you must follow the schedule and help your group be on time, if not early, to every event throughout the days of camp. We will have sponsor free time after the campers go to sleep, including but not limited to food and games. Asking the staff for special privileges is NOT cool!
- 6. Possess an attitude of service – and lead in that way.** We are asking you to join us on a mission that is bigger than any of us as individuals. You will be stretched. You will change. You will plant seeds into the hearts of kids that will grow into something beautiful. We encourage you to have an attitude of service. Lead the campers toward Jesus by serving others as He did.
- 7. If you do not abide by these guidelines your parents will be required to come and pick you up from the camp and take you home at your own expense.**
