Team Expectations

- Participants must be an active member and very involved in Legacy Christian Church.
- Participants must be 16 years or older. If under 18, a parent or guardian must accompany you.
- You must submit a completed application and the \$100 deposit, which will be applied toward the balance of your trip if you are selected. If you are not selected, your money will be refunded.
- Participants must adhere to the Team Covenant as outlined in the application packet. Please read before applying.
- Your application will be reviewed and a personal interview may be required. You will be notified by the Team Leaders if you are approved as a team member no later than one week after the application deadline.
- Short-term mission trips can be rewarding and life-changing; however, they can also be stressful. Please consider factors in your personal life at this time that may distract and prohibit you from committing to the mission of the trip and adapting to unusual conditions.
- When visiting San Raymundo, Guatemala, expect a mountainous environment that may require hiking to access build sites. Be prepared for an adventurous mission trip involving the lifting and carrying of tools and supplies.
- Once accepted, team members are required to attend all team meetings, typically three or four sessions. Before applying, please review your schedule to ensure you can commit to attending these meetings in the months leading up to the trip .
- All trip costs are the team member's responsibility.
- If you are unable to participate in your trip, the Team Leaders must receive cancellation notice as soon as possible. You may be responsible for certain trip costs.
- Team members will be given information regarding passports and vaccination recommendations, when required. Passport and vaccinations costs are not included in the trip costs and are the responsibility of the team member. Team members assume the responsibility and liability for their personal health decisions.
- Each team member will be asked to build a team of 10 prayer supporters before the trip.

Team Covenant

As a member of the team, I agree to:

- Remember that I am representing Jesus Christ, as well as Legacy Christian Church. I will model Jesus in my behavior and attitude.
- Remember that I am a guest working at the invitation of my hosts. I will remember the missionary's prayer, "Where you lead me I will follow, what you feed me I will swallow."
- Remember that we have come to learn, as well as to serve. I'll resist the temptation to inform our hosts about "how we do things." I'll be open to learning about other people's methods and ideas.
- Respect the host's view of Christianity, recognizing that Christianity has many faces throughout the world and that the purpose of this trip is to experience faith lived out in a new setting.
- Develop and maintain a servant attitude toward all nationals and my teammates.
- Respect my Team Leaders and his or her decisions.
- Refrain from gossip.
- Refrain from complaining. Travel can present numerous unexpected and undesired circumstances, but the rewards of conquering such circumstances are innumerable. Instead of whining and complaining, I'll be creative and supportive.
- Attend all team meetings before the trip, as well as any follow up meetings.

- Remember to be inclusive in my relationships. I will make every effort to interact with all the members of the team.

- Remember that I can be sent home, at my own expense, if I do not adhere to this covenant or if my Team Leaders believe it is in my best interest to that of the team.
